UN agencies, the [World Bank](#) and [others](#) forecast that within 30 years as many as 200 million people worldwide will be displaced by climate change impacts. Building on her white paper “[International Climate Migration: What Can U.S. Communities Do?](#),” **Judy Dorsey** will lead us in exploring how any community can benefit from a forward-thinking, inclusive, and compassionate stance on global climate migration and how Colorado can lead the way on this complex topic.

Judy Dorsey is the founding president and principal engineer of Fort Collins-based [Brendle Group](#), a people-centered, impact-driven sustainability consulting firm. Over the last 24 years, Judy has led the completion of more than 300 sustainability projects across the United States, many of which have pioneered new frontiers in sustainability prior to professional protocols, national standards or certifications. Recognizing structural inequities and an increasing level of systemic threats to sustainability, Judy took a 6-month sabbatical in 2019 to study global climate migration and its related parts – social justice, race, poverty, resettlement, and rights of climate migrants. Judy has advised numerous business leaders and public policy makers in managing the risks and opportunities posed by climate change. Her expertise is in combining visionary leadership with practical solutions by distilling complex technical problems into simpler ideas that can be put into action.
