How would your life change with improved Medicare for all?

Larimer County Health Care Action (LCHCA) will conduct a panel discussion on “Improved Medicare for All” (IM4A) at the Salon on **Friday, August 28th**. We will consider what it might be like to enjoy health care without all the stress of the current dysfunctional system, and you’ll learn about legislation that could give you a taste of what IM4A has to offer. The panel of presenters will shed some light on IM4A basics and bust some common myths you may have heard. Through emphasizing shared values and knowing what to say and what not to say, you can become a better and more effective advocate for IM4A.

The four panelists are **Rich Shannon, Emily Galichotte, Julie Rowan-Zoch, and Andrew Boesenecker**. Rich has been engaged in the health care reform movement for fifteen years and is an active volunteer both with the LCHCA and the Colorado Foundation for Universal Health Care. Emily is a virologist and research scientist at Colorado State University. Julie is an author and illustrator of children’s picture books. Both Emily and Julie are members of the Medicare for All Committee of the Democratic Socialists of America, Ft. Collins. Finally, Andrew works for the Semester at Sea program and has used his facilitation talents to share the message of universal, single payer health care financing with Larimer County Health Care Action.
