
Salon duc Tape – Palestine Today – October 9th, 2020

Hope & resilience despite occupation, apartheid, ethnic cleansing & COVID-19

Retired Pastor **Jeff Wright** will lead us through an overview of the current situation in Occupied Palestine at the salon on **Friday, October 9th**. He will touch on the impact of COVID-19, the Abraham Accord ("normalization" of relations between Israel, Bahrain and the UAE), Israel's Nation State Law (which turned Israeli apartheid de facto into apartheid de jure), the so-called "delay" in Israel's annexation plans, and two of the Palestinians' responses ([BDS](#) and [Cry for Hope](#)). There will be ample time for questions and responses.

Jeff is the former pastor of Fort Collins Heart of the Rockies Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), and is currently a Global Mission Worker appointed to [Kairos Palestine](#). He and his wife host alternative (responsible) tours to Palestine/Israel.
